The Coalition of 100 Black Women was founded in New York City in 1970 by 24 Black Women, led by visionary Edna Beach. In 1981, the group decided to create a national organization and on October 24, 1981, renamed it The National Coalition of 100 Black Women (NCBW).

Today, NCBW consists of thousands of women who represents 60 chapters in 25 states and the District of Columbia.

The Tampa Bay Chapter was chartered by Arthenia L. Joyner, Esquire and incorporated on August 3, 1988 and was comprised of a charter membership of 36 women of diverse education and civic background.
